Northern Ireland Tourism Performance 2024

- Figures released by the Northern Ireland Statistics & Research Agency (NISRA) indicate that Northern Ireland (NI) welcomed 4.7 million overnight visitors in 2024, who stayed 14.9 million nights and spent £1.1 billion. These represented declines of 13%, 9% and 10%, respectively, compared to 2023.
- The data indicates a downturn in our closer to home visitor numbers in 2024, broadly stable visitors from Great Britain (GB) and strong growth from Other Overseas visitors (all visitors outside of NI, ROI & GB).
 - Encouragingly, North American trips were up by one quarter compared to January-December 2023, with the growth in North America being primarily driven by the US market whose trips increased by 34% compared to January-December 2023.
 - o While mainland Europe saw a small decline in overall visitor numbers, there was growth evident for key markets including Germany, France, Spain, Netherlands and Italy.
- The average length of stay in NI increased slightly from 3.1 nights in 2023 to 3.2 in 2024, while the average spend per overnight trip grew by 4% (from £233.05 to £224.44).
- Holiday trips and the number of people visiting friends and relatives saw similar declines during
 January-December 2024 compared to the same period last year, while business trips experienced a
 smaller decline. All markets saw a decline in those visiting friends and relatives, while growth in
 holiday visitors from outside of UK and Ireland could not offset the declines in holiday trips by the
 closer to home markets.
- Local Government District figures provide an insight into the regional spread of visitors to NI, with 69% of overnight trips and 57% of spend on these trips taking place outside of Belfast.
- As of March 2024, the number of VAT and/or PAYE tourism businesses operating in Northern Ireland was recorded as 5,865, the highest on record. 77% of the tourism businesses are outside of Belfast City Council.

External Visitor* Origin Insights







GB visitors accounted for 46% of total external trips and almost half of total external spend in 2024. ROI visitors made up over one-third of external trips & had the highest spend per night of all external visitors. North America saw the largest increase in overnight trips to NI in 2024 compared to 2023. Of all external visitors in 2024, Mainland Europe visitors stayed the longest and spent the second most per trip.

Tourism NI Analysis of Other Data Sources



Analysis of 2024 cardholder spend data indicates that spend on NI accommodation fell vs 2023. Growth in spend from overseas visitors was offset by declines in spend by Island of Ireland residents.



Our consumer research found that the vast majority of visitors said their trip matched or exceeded expectations, with the range of places to eat & drink and the welcome & hospitality being particularly highly rated.




Online review analysis also suggests that NI's accommodation establishments and attractions provided a highly positive visitor experience in 2024, on par with performance in 2023.







Notes:

- NISRA advise that due to changes in methodology, users should err caution in comparing 2023 data to previous years.
- Tourism performance estimates presented are based on overnight trips made by Northern Ireland residents and visitors from outside Northern Ireland. Estimates relate to overnight trips only, i.e. exclude day trips.
- External visitors include all visitors from outside Northern Ireland.
- Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
- Regional spend is calculated using monthly exchange rates, while individual country spend is calculated using quarterly exchange rates. For this reason, summing the country spend may not equal the total regional spend.
