## Northern Ireland Tourism Performance 2023

- Figures released by the Northern Ireland Statistics & Research Agency (NISRA) indicate that Northern Ireland welcomed 5.4 million overnight visitors in 2023, who stayed 16.5 million nights and spent £1.2 billion.
- On average, visitors stayed 3.1 nights and spent £224.45 per overnight trip in Northern Ireland in 2023.
- Holiday trips were the most popular reason for visiting Northern Ireland, consisting of more than half of all visits (51%). Visiting friends and relatives was the second most popular reason for visiting (38%).
- Domestic trips made up 40% of overnight trips taken in Northern Ireland, highlighting the importance of the domestic tourism market. Trips by Great Britain residents accounted for the second highest proportion of overall trips at 27%.
- We welcomed an unprecedented number of Republic of Ireland visitors in 2023, and our consumer sentiment research found that the majority of Republic of Ireland visitors said their trip matched or exceeded expectations, with the range of places to eat & drink and the welcome & hospitality being particularly highly rated.
- Local Government District figures provide an insight into the regional spread of visitors to Northern Ireland, with 69% of overnight trips and 56% of spend on these trips taking place outside of Belfast.
- As of March 2023, the number of VAT and/or PAYE tourism businesses operating in Northern Ireland was recorded as 5,845, the highest on record. 77% of the tourism businesses are outside of Belfast City Council.



#### **External Visitor Origin Insights**



GB visitors accounted for 44% of total external trips and almost half of total external spend in 2023.



ROI visitors made up two-fifths of external trips & had the highest spend per night of all external visitors in 2023.



North America had the highest proportion of external holiday visitors in 2023 with these visitors spending £43m.



Of all external visitors to NI in 2023, Other Overseas visitors stayed the longest and spent the most per trip.







# Notes:

- NISRA advise that due to changes in methodology, users should err caution in comparing 2023 data to previous years.
- Tourism performance estimates presented are based on overnight trips made by Northern Ireland residents and visitors from outside Northern Ireland. Estimates relate to overnight trips only, i.e. excludes day trips.
- External visitors include all visitors from outside Northern Ireland.
- Percentages may not equal 100% due to rounding.
- Regional spend is calculated using monthly exchange rates, while individual country spend is calculated using quarterly exchange rates. For this reason, summing the country spend may not equal the total regional spend.
